Original Purposes of JECJEF University

Selectivity of JECJEF University

JECJEF University standards correlate with Research I accreditation expectations.

Knowledge: the selection of coursework and courses “Knowledge does not simply happen. Real people create it, individually or in groups, affected by the social context in which they live...which surrounds us all; that context may provide a background, influence or become itself the subject of study.” (p. 132, Theory of Knowledge, New York: Oxford, 2007)

Reasoning: The purpose of coursework and course “Abstract thinking, planning, and imagination are cognitive capacities.” (p. 64) “Reasoning can scarcely be separated from the thinking...We consider abstract ideas and symbols, and manipulate them into poems, mathematical formulae, musical scores,..., political speeches. We make decisions, we set goals, and...we organize, research, and plan; We solve problems....We decide that information which we had learned in the past is pertinent to our present....We select, compile,..., compare, contrast, classify, name, count, estimate, and calculate....We reason, we induce, deduce, infer, generalize, specify, recognize similarities, and draw analogies....We...argue endlessly about what is true, good, right, beautiful, and just...and what is not....”(p. 64)
